- * Provide a sack lunch for your child in childcare, if your project is expected to extend beyond lunch time.

#1 “Dress a Girl” & Fleece Blanket Projects

#4 Habitat for Humanity
 We will help out where needed with Habitat for Humanity Montgomery County. Lunch will be provided. We will return to WCPC in the afternoon.
ADULTS AND YOUTH 16+ YEARS

#5 Gathering Place
 This crew will be in the WCPC kitchen making and freezing chili and other food items to be used for Gathering Place events.

#6 Creation Care Team
 We will join efforts with members of the Creation Care Team to clean up WCPC grounds and the perimeters of our campus and the Panther Creek Village Center.
AGES 4 AND OVER (UNDER 13 WITH PARENT)

#7 Montgomery County Food Bank
 We will sort and distribute food at the site of one of the Food Bank’s partners. This team will return to WCPC by early afternoon.

#8 Montgomery County Women’s Shelter
 The Montgomery County Women’s Shelter has many items that need to be sorted, organized and boxed within their facility. This team will return to WCPC by early afternoon.

#9 Hand Me Up Shop Crew
 We will help the people at Interfaith’s Hand Me Up resale shop dig out from under the piles of clothing donations and put their shop in order. We will be back at church before noon.

#10 Breakfast Team
 But who will take care of the breakfast for all the participants? We will! Come help set up, start the coffee, clean up and basically take care of all the workers. And then go home early or participate in one of the projects on site.

 The children will help decorate Meals on Wheels breakfast bags, make Valentines and door hangers for seniors in the area, help clean up the WCPC campus with the Creation Care Team and end with a visit to our neighbors at The Forum.

 We will work in the warehouse sorting and packing donated medical supplies to send to countries facing poverty and disease. We will return to WCPC by early afternoon.
