## March

1-3 Conclaves Cho-Yeh (7-12<sup>th</sup> grade as of March 2019)

Cho Yeh Camp dates start the 1<sup>st</sup> week of June and go through August. WCPC Children's and Tweens Ministry encourages our children involved in Sunday school and Worship to attend a week of Cho Yeh Camp on a date when other WCPC children are going. These dates are published in early February so you can plan accordingly. Attending camp allows our children to bond more fully with each other while playing games, participating in Bible devotions and rooming in cabins together. Hopefully these friendships will form the basis for youth group friendships as the children and tweens mature into youth group. We also offer camp scholarship and discounts that can be applied for by filling out a request form. This form can be online on our church website or you can request one from Susan Duncan. The discounts and scholarships are based on money raised from the Rummages Sale and Game Night. The amount raised is divided amongst the number of participants, so the amount awarded varies from year to year. We are also handing out Camp Scholarship Covenants with further information on how camp scholarships are decided and how parents and children can help raise the funds during the year. The deadline to apply for the discount or scholarship is March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. Camp Cho Yeh is for children who have completed 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2019 school year. Children completing 7<sup>th</sup> grade are encouraged to go to Mo Ranch camp with the Jr. High group. Cho Yeh's Road Crew sadly cannot make our Trunk or Treat this year. They bring information, camp staff and a climbing wall with them along with inflatable games. We may try to schedule them in the spring date TBA.
