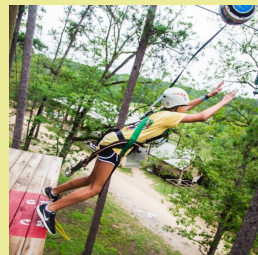

MISSION OUTREACH

- **Mission Outreach Team (MOT) Meeting - Tuesday, January 8th at 7pm in Room 301B of the Hendricks Bldg (HEB).** All are welcome!
- **DeGeorge Transitional Housing for Veterans-** Thanks to everyone who donated stocking stuffers and to the women attending the Christmas Luncheon for stuffing the stockings. We were able to provide stockings for all 100 residents. In addition, we brought 26 bags of Just Coffee, 14 blankets and 16 twin sheet sets ,which were purchased using funds donated at the Alternative Market, to the director of the facility to use/distribute when needed.
- **Angel Tree -** Thanks to everyone who participated in the Angel Tree Mission Project. We were able to provide presents to 42 children in the Foster Care and Adoption Program run by the Presbyterian Children's Homes & Services, 4 needy families from the surrounding community and five senior citizens in need through Interfaith of The Woodlands.
- **WCPC Food Pantry -** In 2019, we are expanding our pantry to include items for the Meals on Wheels Montgomery County (MOWMC) Breakfast Bags and Kids' Meals lunch bags in addition to the Interfaith Food Pantry. **January special needs for Interfaith:** boxed or bagged cereal, oatmeal, granola bars, bar soap and/or body wash. **Ongoing needs:** peanut butter, jam, cleaning products (no spray bottles), laundry detergent, personal hygiene items, diapers and baby wipes. **Special needs for MOWMC:** Ensure or Glucerna and packets of instant oatmeal. **Special needs for Kids' Meals:** individual packets of peanut butter (Jif to Go) and individual boxes of raisins. Bring donations to the pantry in the sanctuary narthex anytime.
