Gordy gave the devotional from D365 April 30, 2017 and opened the meeting with prayer.

David reported for the Session:

- Rita Van Sickle was honored for her 25 years as director of ELP. She's retiring at the end of this school year.
- Cindy Mountain was introduced as the new director for ELP.
- Shirley Barclay was approved as the 'Director of Communication.'

Project Reports:

- Nancy Hathaway presented a project from the youth team. They wish to collect old MP3 players for a music therapy program for persons with dementia. They would work with 'Sure Care at Home' in uploading music. A member of our congregation, Michelle Woodside, is a volunteer at Sure Care. A motion was made and passed to allow the youth to pursue this program from now through August 2017.
- Peru
 - 1. Sicuani We are awaiting confirmation \$2,500 wire transfer sent to them.
 - 2. 2017 Mission Trips
 - a. Sicuani July 21 26, have 3 WCPC members going, 1 considering
 - b. Lima July 26 Aug 3, have 6 WCPC members going, 2 considering.
 There will be no VBS, and there is no ophthalmologist. Providing reading glasses only. Without the ophthalmologist, the \$1,200 budgeted for glasses will need to be reallocated. It was decided to let the Peru Team do the reallocation.
 - c. Ayaviri Aug 4 14, No WCPC members going.
 - d. Chazuta Aug 30-Sept 7, No WCPC members going.

- Africa –Michele and John are going to Africa for Tommy Banda's graduation on May 13, 2017. There are also going to Siavonga and visiting with UCZ. They are taking computers for Tommy and Naomi DaKa. Naomi is our new seminary student at Justo.
- ESL The last day is May 11.
- Family Promise Warren says we have three families in the program. There is a possibility of a fourth. He encouraged sign ups both to help with the sign up and with the programs. We are going to give a \$100 gift card to the family that presented the Faith in Action on Sunday April 30. The program is June 4 to June 18.
- Trinity Episcopal will host Faiths Together Giving Thanks program in the fall.
- Montgomery County Homeless Coalition has an advocate; Ed Allen. They have found housing for three chronically homeless people in Montgomery County.

Mission Facilitator's Report:

- Bread for the World Michele told us Bread for the World is changing its program some by planning local listening sessions with representatives in addition to their annual Lobby Day in Washington D.C. Its goal is to eliminate hunger worldwide by 2030. Church leaders from supportive churches in our congregational district have been invited to participate in the Washington Lobby Day June 13. Rev Jones was asked to attend. MOT was asked to fund part of the trip. After considerable discussion, we elected not to approve funds for the trip. Concerns were raised about the short timing and lack of an advocate for Bread for the World.
- \$4784 has been collected for OGHS.
- Pentecost Offering is June 4. The local portion goes to CASA, Court Appointed Special Advocates.
- Social Justice Nancy Heintz is putting together a program for Poverty Simulation. The program was developed by Entergy. It is three hours long. Preliminary timing is Nov 4 in fellowship hall.
- Just Coffee Sales are slowing. Mary Emerson will be doing a 'Faith in Action to promote sales.
- Reviewed Correspondence and the 'Thank You' notes received.
