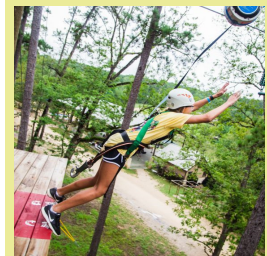


ALL CHURCH FELLOWSHIP COOKIES, COCOA & CAROLING
