Living the Questions has published a new study titled ProFuture Faith. From their website:

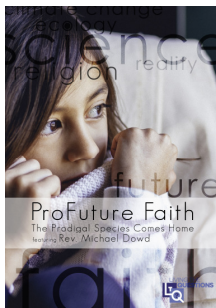
