Meet at Shadowbend Pool for the all-church Pool Party. There is no fee to get in. Come swim with your church family.

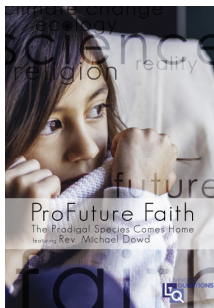
