



The celebration begins on Friday, October 18, at 10am at Lirio de Los Valles Presbyterian Church in Agua Prieta, Sonora, and concludes with Sunday worship at 9am on October 20. The host hotel for the weekend is Motel La Hacienda in Agua Prieta, Sonora, and a no-cost housing option is available at the New Hope Community Center. Meals and hotel rooms can be reserved on the <u>registration form</u>.
